Students who complete a minor in Organizational Leadership (OL) will be come more effective organization members, whether their chosen career is in business, non-profits, arts, agriculture, service, sales, or government. Students will possess strong leadership, communication, team building, and ethical decision-making skills, along with a greater understanding of organizational behavior. Students will utilize their skills to analyze, interpret, and reflect on the impact a local organization has on its people (and vice versa); providing a career-enhancing performance learning opportunity and developing a network of professional contacts while still at Millikin. The minor includes an internship at a local business as a culminating course.
